- UEI Numbers with SAM.GOV Libraries will need to annually renew their UEI numbers with SAM.gov. A UEI number will be required to file future State Aid Reports. Libraries are encouraged to create a file for library establishment documents and SAM.GOV paperwork to be accessed when needed. Refer to the Library of Michigan library establishment sheet found here: <u>Michigan</u> <u>Library Establishment Types</u> to find out the establishment documents likely needed for application and renewal.
- APTAC Assistance with SAM.GOV accounts Libraries who need more in-depth assistance with UEI creation or renewal may consider reaching out to their local APTAC for assistance.
