




## What is your library role? Choose one that fits best:




## Where do you get information about the Mid-Michigan Library League and its programs and services?





## What kind of training opportunities are you looking for from Mid-Michigan Library League? (choose all that apply)







## Which type of training would best suit your learning style?




## How far would you be willing to travel for training?




Do you believe it is important for the Mid-Michigan Library League to be on Facebook and other social media websites?
