Harry Potter Escape Room
When we decided to do a Harry Potter escape room we did a google search for "Harry Potter Escape Room Library" and came up with this program.

This is how we made it our own after reading what they had done.

Our room size 10 'x12'. The large props we had in the room are a table for a desk, a library book cart, a small book shelf, a trunk (could use any storage bin), and small plant stands. We did not purchase any of these they were brought in by staff.
For small props we had:

- Many books from our reference shelves as they were the oldest looking books we had.
- A bird cage with feathers from a boa... We said this was Fawkes' molt
- Plants both live and fake, a belt wrapped chest.
- On desk: a picture frame with a Dumbledore quote, candle sticks, vase with fake flowers, old bust, small chest with keys.
- Cauldrons, a sorting had, weird bottles with colored water in them
- In the chest we put robes (graduation gowns work), earmuffs, and the large breakout edu box
- A globe, a stand with a book (Burke's peerage from the library)

This is how our room was supposed to go, most people did not do it in this order:

1. In the room were hidden 8 rocks that had runes on one side and numbers on the other. Also in the room was a Rune Dictionary that we had put together.
2. The runes on the stones spelled mandrake. We had created a mandrake out of clay, fake plants, and string from a YouTube video. In the chest in the room were earmuffs that they had to put on before pulling the mandrake. If they did not they got a 2 minute penalty.
3. After pulling the mandrake they found a key in the roots. This key unlocked the breakout edu box (which we called contraband) and a belt wrapped chest with a padlock.
4. The contaband box held 2 old Nokia phones, a magnifying glass with light, a calculator, and a battery. The battery is for a black light used later. In the chest is a piece of paper and a diary. The diary is locked.
5. The piece of paper is a pondering by Professor Dumbledore about a parchment (Marauder's Map) that he found and can't figure out. In the pondering there are bold words which are places on the Marauder's Map. These places have a letter next to them on the map. The map is sitting out on the desk. We chose for ours to spell out the numbers: Three, Nine, Four.
6. The digits go into a book safe which has the black light in it.
7. On the desk is a chest full of keys, the diary key is among them. Most people tried all the keys in the belt chest and contraband box. Once the diary is open they find it belonged to Myrtle. It is for the year just before she dies. Some of the entries have illustrations and the last entry is the clue to decide which portrait to look at.
8. After assembling the black light and battery they then shine the light around the room. On the wall are 6 portraits of headmasters, one of them has writing in black light markers "Alohomora to escape". The patrons had to say "Alohomora to escape" before we allowed them to escape.

Here are our escape scenario, diary entries, and Dumbledore parchment:

## Escape Scenario

Why are they in Dumbledore's office?
Hello Students,
You have snuck up to Dumbledore's office in order to use the pensive. As you were finishing you noticed that the door was locked and you could not located the key. You now have to try and find a way to get out of the office before you are found.

You must escape the office. You have half an hour to solve all the puzzles. You do not need to rip anything or take anything off the walls. You will be given no hints (Unless we felt they were needed). If you do not complete the puzzles before the 30 minutes are up you will get detention.

We had a couple of rooms run with 2 or 3 players and we did give them some hints.
