- Registration is now open for the Small Libraries, Big Impact conference and we are
  expecting the spots to fill in nicely, with the initial registration distributed among the six
  sponsoring library cooperatives. The program has filled in nicely with great keynotes and
  interesting individual break-out sessions. We look forward to this event being successful
  and then repeated on years opposite from the Loleta Fyan conference.
- Our Continuing Education Committee is working on short (less than five minute) videos to
  post on our cooperative's YouTube channel to assist members with quick information at the

- We have member libraries undergoing expansions, such as the Glen Lake Community
  Library in Empire, which will be in a temporary location while work is done on their new
