

# VOTING OPTIONS

## Register



- ➔ **Recommended:** Register by mail/online at [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote) for the Nov. 3 general election through Oct. 19.
- ➔ Register in person at your local clerk's office up to and on Election Day and vote while there. Visit [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote) for clerk information.

## Request to have an absentee ballot sent to you



- ➔ Apply online or download an application at [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote). Accessible applications are also available. If you download, sign the application and then email or mail it to your local clerk.
- ➔ **Recommended:** Apply as soon as possible and by Oct. 19.

## Vote early or on Election Day



- ➔ **Early:** Ballots sent to your home must be received by your clerk by 8 p.m. Election Day. SIGN THE BACK OF THE ENVELOPE and return:
  - By delivering the ballot to your clerk's drop box or office; or
  - By mailing your ballot (recommended by Oct. 19).
- ➔ **Early:** Visit your local clerk's office from Sept. 24 through Nov. 2.
- ➔ **Election Day:** Go to your polling place or, if not yet registered, your clerk's office. Find both at [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote).
- ➔ **Note:** Clerk's offices and polling places will be supplied with protective and hygiene supplies, and will follow protocols to ensure safe in-person voting.
